

**Desire2Learn (D2L): A NEW Online Course Tool for Virtual Classes**

All undergraduate level courses will use Desire2Learn, *except for the courses on page 4*.  
Students are required to take a D2L orientation, which will cover the tool's features.

**Note on Blended (VB) Courses**

**WEBADVISOR (WA) REGISTRATION TIPS**

Our system gets very busy at 9 am on the first day of regular registration. Here are a few tips to assist you:

<b>PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF REGISTRATION: BE READY!!!</b>	<b>ON THE FIRST DAY OF REGISTRATION:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* <b>Make sure you can access WebAdvisor.</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Go to the Current Student home page @ <a href="http://www.walshcollege.edu/current_students">http://www.walshcollege.edu/current_students</a></li> <li>2. Click Active Campus Portal.</li> <li>3. Follow log in instructions.</li> <li>4. Locate WebAdvisor near the bottom right corner of the Student Home page.</li> </ol> </li> <li>* <b>Put classes on your preferred list through WA.</b> Then you will be able to go directly to WebAdvisor, click "Registration", "Register for Classes", and "Register for Previously Selected Classes" on the first day of registration. This saves time.  Quicker option: Go to <a href="https://myportal.walshcollege.edu">https://myportal.walshcollege.edu</a>, login and click "Course Search/Registration"; create your "Preferred List"; click on "View My Preferred List" and you will be taken to WebAdvisor to register.</li> <li>* <b>Make sure you know your login and have your password up to date.</b> Passwords expire every 90 days. If you need to reset yours, go to the "Change/Reset Password" form available at <a href="https://www-secure.walshcollege.edu/PasswordReset">https://www-secure.walshcollege.edu/PasswordReset</a>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* <b>Log in after 9 am.</b> If you access WA <i>before</i> 9 am, you will get a "You're not eligible to register" error message – even once it turns 9 am. (If you get this message, log out and log back in.)</li> <li>* <b>Use "Express Registration" or "Register for Previously Selected Classes" for faster processing times.</b></li> <li>* <b>Avoid using the "Search and Register for Classes" link.</b> Have classes on your preferred list in advance and use "Register for Previously Selected Classes". If you must use "Search and Register for Classes", be sure to <i>narrow down your results by entering 2-3 search criteria (e.g. term, subject <u>and</u> course level OR term, subject, <u>and</u> course number).</i></li> <li>* <b>Be Patient!</b> During heavy usage, processing may take a few extra seconds.</li> <li>* <b>Wait until later.</b> If you are in a program where classes do not fill quickly, consider registering later.</li> <li>* <b>Log out.</b> Once you finish registering, log out so others can log in!</li> <li>* <b>If you do not plan to register the first day – be kind to your fellow classmates by not logging in!</b></li> </ul>

## WAITLIST (WL) PROGRAM

All courses offer a waitlist option. If a course you are eligible to take fills, you will have the option to go on a waitlist. If a seat opens later, an e-mail will be sent to your **Walsh e-mail account**. You will have until noon of the next day to register for the seat. To register for the open seat, go to the "Manage My Waitlist" link on WebAdvisor and select the course. If you no longer want the seat, go to "Manage My Waitlist" to remove yourself from the WL. **Please note that being placed on a WL does not guarantee a seat in the class.** (Note: The Waitlist feature will be turned off on March 21. At that time, registering for open seats will be on a first come, first served basis.)

## EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION

**Note:** Orientation for Online and Blended courses is mandatory for new online students.

Online course orientations can be completed entirely online (OOL 001\*R1 or D2L 001\*R1).

In-class sessions are also offered (OOL 001\*R2-R3 or D2L 001\*R2-R3).

Students who pass the placement exam will be eligible to enroll in COM 320. Students who do not pass the placement exam will be required to take COM 300, Communication Essentials, prior to taking COM 320.
