Marsha Kelliher was named president and CEO of Walsh College, effective April 2017. The Walsh College Board of Trustees voted unanimously to appoint her to succeed current president Stephanie W. Bergeron, who announced last spring that she would retire. Bergeron had held the position since 2007. Ed Gwilt, chairman of the Walsh College Board of Trustees announced the appointment in a news release.

Kelliher was previously dean of the Sigmund Weis School of Business at Susquehanna University in Selinsgrove, Pennsylvania. Previously, she worked at St. Edward's University in Austin, Texas for 19 years, where she held numerous leadership roles, including dean of the School of Management and Business, and oversaw graduate and undergraduate business programs.

Kelliher has a master of laws degree in labor and employment law from the University of San Diego and a juris doctor from South Texas College of Law. She has a bachelor's degree from Indiana University.
