

Walsh College president to retire next year

Troy — The president of Walsh College will retire from the Metro Detroit business school early next year, the college announced Wednesday.

Stephanie Bergeron, the school's first woman president and CEO, has led the Troy-based college since January 2007.

"Stephanie has provided exceptional leadership in guiding the college through an important period of academic advancement and facilities modernization," said Edward Gwilt, chairman of the school's board of trustees.

Bergeron led initiatives that included a \$5 million fundraising campaign for scholarships and a \$15 million addition and renovation of Walsh's Troy campus, the school said in a release.

The school also has a campus in Novi and locations at Macomb Community College in Clinton Township and St. Clair Community College in Port Huron.
