

LOCATION

- Zion Christian Church is located on the east side of Livernois between Wattles and Big Beaver roads, just south of the Walsh College Troy campus.
- The main entrance is on the south side of the building.
- Parking is available at Zion as well as the Walsh College Troy campus.

GUEST ARRIVAL TIME & LOCATION
