Undergraduate Cost Comparison: Walsh vs. Four-year Colleges

Total Cost Comparison

Many of our undergraduate students transfer to Walsh from community college. Because of Walsh College's unique transfer structure, we are one of the region's most affordable options.

Transfer school: The average cost of 82 semester credit hours from a Community College at \$105 per credit hour. = \$8,610

+

Walsh College: 45 semester credit hours at Walsh, based on an average of \$460 per credit hour. = \$20,700*

Walsh Total: 127 semester credit hours needed for a bachelor's degree. = **\$29,310**

Four-year Public College = \$62,357**
Estimated cost of a bachelor's degree from a local four-year public college, based on tuition alone with an average rate of \$491 per credit hour, 127 hours of instruction.
