Notes:

1. Exam Prep Review Sessions are designed to be offered on the weekend before each exam. In some courses, because of the staggered semester starts, duplicate sessions are offered on consecutive weekends. Students usually attend the session on the weekend before each exam in their course.
2. Exam Prep Review Sessions offer new problems beyond those in the course pack and text. Instructors briefly discuss highlights of key areas, then “walk through” those new problems with students.
3. Exam Prep Review Sessions are more classroom style than “labs” or “Q&A Review Sessions,” which are designed to answer student questions on a walk-in basis. Most of the two-hour sessions focus on the problem handout distributed by the Review Session instructor.
