

FA21 Peregrine External Assessment Results

107 Walsh undergraduate and graduate students completed a Peregrine external assessment in FA21. The assessments were administered in 11 courses to gather data on 19 programs: 8 UG, 11 GR.

Of those 107 students, 52 scored "Above Average", "High" or "Very High". 40 students scored "Average", and just 14% scored "Below", "Low" or "Very Low".

The average Peregrine score for undergraduate students was 59%: the average score for graduate students was 57%.
