# SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Over 100 scholarship opportunities are available for new students who are enrolled for a minimum of six credits at Walsh.

## **DeRoy Testamentary Foundation Scholarship**

Full scholarship for tuition and fees for new students admitted into a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.800 or higher – maximum of two awards available per academic year dependent on fund availability.

## **Community College Excellence Award**

Admitted new student with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.750 and 60 credits from a Michigan community college.

## **Jeffery W. Barry Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to the Bachelor of Accountancy program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.750.

## **Archie D. Waring Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.500.

## **Golf Classic Annual Scholarship**

Admitted new student with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.500.

## **Deloitte Foundation Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to the Bachelor of Accountancy program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.400 and the ability to demonstrate leadership.

## **Leadership Awards Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.300.

## **Kevin J. Carmody Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to the Bachelor of Accountancy program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.000. Preference is given to students transferring from an area community college.

## **Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program from a community college with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.000.

## **Tower Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.000. Preference will be given to minority applicants.

## **W. Margaret Walsh Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.000. Must be working at least part-time.

## **Arthur & Rita Schmaltz Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.500.

## **Pearson Endowed Scholarship**

Admitted new student to a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.500. Must be a graduate of a Detroit high school or a transfer student from Wayne County Community College District or Highland Park Community College. Must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and demonstrate financial need.
