## TO BE ADMITTED AND TRANSFER

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.000 is required.

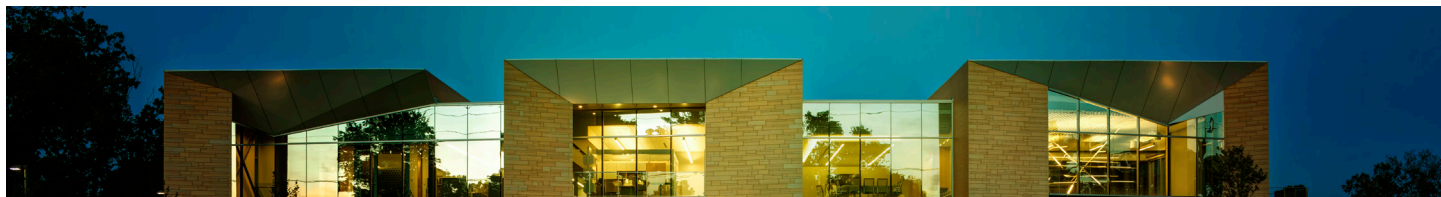
- ☐ BAC, BBA, and BSIT – transfer up to 82 credits
  - 60 semester credit hours with a grade of “C” or higher to include 30 semester credit hours of general education credits including one course in English composition/written communication and mathematics (intermediate algebra/higher level math course).
- ☐ BSAM – transfer up to 90 credits
  - An approved two or three year diploma in an applied science/technology program
