

Scholarships for Service Members

Walter P. Rinkus Memorial Scholarship for Veterans

This scholarship was established by Mike and Judy Rinkus to honor Mike's father Walter P. Rinkus. Mike is a veteran himself, a full time member of the College's Economics and Finance Departments.

Applicants will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:

- Applicant must be enrolled or admitted to Walsh.
- Preference is given to a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces.
- Applicant must show financial need.
- Applicant can be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree with a preference to a student in the finance program.
- Student must demonstrate successful academic performance by entering the college with a 2.5 GPA and maintain a satisfactory GPA for the degree they are pursuing.
- Student holding the scholarship shall have preference in subsequent years if academic performance is maintained.
- Students using VA Education Benefits at 100% are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

The Robinson-Coleman Endowed Scholarship for Veterans

This scholarship was created by one of our alums, Amy Coleman, BAC '90. Amy is Vice President and Chief Financial Officer at The Kresge Foundation in Troy, Michigan. She is establishing this scholarship to honor several of her family members who served in the United States military, and to recognize all veterans for their valiant service.

Applicants will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:

- Applicant must be enrolled or admitted to Walsh.
- Preference given to a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces.
- Applicant must show financial need.
- Applicant can be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree.
- Student must demonstrate successful academic performance by entering the college with a 2.5 GPA and maintain a satisfactory GPA for the degree they are pursuing.
- Students using VA Education Benefits at 100% are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

Requirements

1. Show proof of veteran status.
2. Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form at www.fafsa.gov.
3. Fill out the internal scholarship application found at www.walshcollege.edu/vetfinaid.
4. Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.500 (on a 4.000 scale).
